>>> number, affiliation, country.

>>> - In a supplementary file they will attach the pdf of the  
>>> conference letter as it has been selected as the best paper for  
>>> the Special Issue along with the peer reviews that have been made  
>>> during the conference

>>> Author Guidelines  
>>>  
>>> - Formatting: Authors should use the journal's templates to

>>> format their articles. Microsoft Word (doc) templates are  
>>> available on the website. Failure to follow these guidelines will  
>>> result in additional work for JIEM editors and staff, potentially  
>>> leading to immediate rejection of your paper. Ensure your  
>>> submission meets the formatting requirements.

>>> - Previous Presentations and Improvements: As your paper was  
>>> previously presented at CIO 2024, it must be substantially  
>>> improved to be considered for review. Include proper references to  
>>> these previous publications. The journal requires that articles do  
>>> not closely resemble the 6-page template in length, content, or  
>>> contribution.

>>> - Evaluation Process: An article submitted to JIEM will be  
>>> evaluated by the editor-in-chief. Only if the editor-in-chief  
>>> accepts the manuscript will it proceed to publication.

>>> - Rejection Policy: The editor-in-chief has the authority to  
>>> reject a submission. The main reasons are:

>>> x Poor use of English

>>> x The papers do not meet with the focus and scope of the  
>>> journal

>>> x Low scientific quality of the paper

>>> x No following the author guidelines of the journal

>>> x Received after the deadline

>>> x Copyright or plagiarism problems

>>> - Publication Fee: The minimum publication fee is 495 EUR  
>>> per accepted paper. It should be managed by the authors at their  
>>> own expense.

>>> - Submission Deadline: The deadline for receiving papers in  
>>> JIEM is 30-10 2024.

>>> - Publication Date: The publication date is scheduled for  
>>> April-May 2025.
